Ministry of Social Affairs and Labor under the Ministerial Resolution No. 266 of 2007 issued on December 31, 2007 as a charitable organization aiming to contribute to improving the conditions of orphans in the Social Care Houses, as well as enhancing the spirit of citizenship and the culture of development for this emerging category and the youth, besides the training of Kuwaiti cadres as social and psychological specialists, and creating job opportunities in addition to the necessary qualification for this category in cooperation with official and private authorities, as well as providing scholarships and cash prizes for this category in order to encourage them to excel be outstanding, besides organizing religious, educational and promotional activities for them, and implementing any other activity of charitable acts and public benefit according to what is approved by the board of directors of the Foundation, in a manner that does not conflict with the purposes of its establishment as well as the official laws and decisions regulating it. After one year of the establishment, the founders proposed adding new segments, namely the elderly, people with special needs and chronic diseases.

LOCAL PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES



Local Projects and Activities

Since its establishment in late 2007 and the beginning of 2008, Khairal-Kuwait Charity Foundation has embarked on a number of projects and activities of a social and humanitarian character, especially with regard to orphans, and particularly the orphans of the social care houses in the Ministry of Social Affairs, in an effort to encourage and support the values of volunteer work because of its good and pioneering role in the advancement of the Kuwaiti society, and the spreading of mercy and interdependence among its various segments and groups, by providing an incubator environment for the targeted groups by the Foundation in order to improve their conditions and living, in accordance with the saying of the Messenger of Allah, may God bless him and grant him peace: (The example of the believers in their friendship, compassion, and sympathy like the body if one organ of it complains, the rest of the body will stay up to over the night to share feverish pains).

The Foundation has implemented a number of projects and activities, and we will discuss the most important projects and activities that Khairal-Kuwait Charity Foundation is implementing within the State of Kuwait, including awareness, entertainment and cultural projects, training courses, assistance in forming families for orphans, effective cooperation and partnership agreements with local bodies, as follows:

Studies to Determine the Needs of Orphans

Foundation began its journey by preparing studies to find out the needs of orphans in terms of psychological, health and physical aspects. A thorough study was prepared through a consulting office in which the priorities and needs that should be implemented for orphans were determined, and other comprehensive surveys were prepared on the level of residential buildings in which orphans live, in order to know the size of the necessary needs. The Foundation made a deliberate plan for the projects and activities of the Foundation to serve orphans and provide for their needs, and an agreement was subsequently concluded with a legal consulting office to provide legal advice to the foundation, and the Foundation approved its work plan through studies that were implemented from the recommendations that were approved.



Visits to H. H. The Amir of Kuwait Sheikh Sabah Al Ahmed Al Jaber Al Sabah

At the beginning of the establishment of the Foundation, a visit was made to His Highness the Amir of Kuwait Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah, to introduce him to the foundation, its humanitarian goals and its future projects. He was informed of the foundation's plan and its desire to implement various activities and programs for orphans, and to restore and rehabilitate orphans' buildings. His Highness praised this initiative and expressed his willingness to donate and contribute to the restoration of orphanages at his own expense, and this meeting had a great positive motivation among the members of the Board of Directors of the Foundation to actively and effectively strive to provide the best services for orphans, and his Highness contributed to the restoration of orphanages in 2010, and the Foundation officials paid many visits to him to thank him for his donation and his reception of orphans on several occasions when they visited him to motivate and encourage them.



«To my Orphan Brother» competition

Since its inception in 2008, the Foundation has held an annual competition entitled «My Orphan Brother Competition», in cooperation with the Ministry of Education. The competition aims to preserve the language of the Holy Qur'an, and the discovery of the talents in the fields of literature, poetry and drawing as well as encouraging the caring for orphans and assist them. Orphan students interacted with the competition and showed their creativity and distinguished talents in this competition. The competition continued annually with distinction and excellence, and was proposed to the Arabic League so as to circulate it to all Arab countries, and this competition has been approved so as to be executed soon.

Organizing Recreational Activities and Trips for Orphans

The entertainment for orphans, especially the guests of the social care houses in the Ministry of Social Affairs, is one of the most important activities provided by Khairal-Kuwait Charity Foundation, with the aim of bringing joy and happiness to the hearts of this category that was deprived of the blessing of parents, and with the aim of providing a social incubator that contributes to their integration into the society and restores confidence for them in order to compensate them for the deprivation of the sympathy of the father and mother.





Organizing Recreational Activities and Trips for Orphans

The various entertainment facilities include trips to shopping malls, children's entertainment cities, parks, sports clubs, theaters and cinemas.

The Foundation is also keen that the orphans enjoy the local seasonal atmosphere associated with specific occasions such as the establishment of spring camps on land, chalets, and swimming pools in the summer, so that orphans do not feel that there is no difference between them and their peers of unequal treatment, and that they live their lives naturally.





Providing Collective Meals

As wisdom says, «A healthy mind in a healthy body», Khairal-Kuwait Foundation is keen to take care of the health and food of orphans and to diversify the same away from the monotony, so it bears the cost of providing meals and foodstuffs on a regular basis, including the provision of nutritious meals such as breakfast, lunch, dinner and fast food in the most luxurious restaurants and hotels, in order to bring pleasure to their hearts.

The matter is not limited to orphans only, but also includes their supervisors in order to create a family atmosphere between them and break the monotony and routine. The Foundation also is keen that the children's diets be balanced and enjoying useful nutrients, in order to preserve their health. Therefore, these meals are made through companies, restaurants and hotels capable of preparing suitable meals for them, with the aim of bringing joy and pleasure to all orphans to try to integrate them into society and make them feel that there is no difference between them and their normal peers who have families who care for them and take care of them, their health and their food.




Construction Projects

Khairal-Kuwait Foundation contributes to some construction projects in children care houses in the Ministry of Social Affairs as well as some houses and public benefit authorities, in order to extend the bridges of cooperation and ties of cooperation with them for serving and benefiting certain categories of the Kuwaiti society, including orphans and handicapped.

The construction projects included certain rooms related to the care for orphans in the social care houses in the Ministry of Social Affairs and some public benefit buildings such as swimming pools, children rooms and other rooms for the security guards.

H. H. The Amir of Kuwait Sheikh Sabah Al Ahmed Al Jaber Al Sabah took the initiative in the year 2010 and borne the expenses for rehabilitation of the buildings of Children House in the Ministry of Social Affairs through the donation by H.H. The Amir for Khairal-Kuwait Foundation of all costs of the rehabilitation process. This reassures the sympathy and compassion of H.H. The Amir towards his orphan children.





Education Seekers

Khairal-Kuwait Foundation pays great attention to the educational process for orphans and other groups of people with special needs in order to arm themselves with education and knowledge. This is based on the Foundation belief that "knowledge raises houses that have no support and ignorance destroys houses of honor and generosity.

The foundation has adopted many projects for the students who seek knowledge and education, and it incurred educational expenses and scholarship fees for the outstanding ones among them in order to obtain the best and most prestigious certificates from local and international universities and academies, with the aim of creating such a generation of orphans which is duly armed with science and knowledge in order to serve his country. Many orphans who were sponsored by the Foundation have obtained higher degrees such as masters and doctorates in various fields of science, and they were up to the responsibility that the Foundation granted to them. Also, the Foundation is guite keen to provide continuous support for orphan students, especially the outstanding ones among them, and it bears the costs of study no matter what their education costs, based on its humanitarian role in serving orphans and considering them as a part of the society and that they must be taken care of, for their best upgrading and advancement.





Orphans treatment

The work of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation is not limited to providing an environment and social incubator for orphans and other groups targeted by the foundation, but has also worked to provide the necessary health care for them by providing examinations and treatment for sick orphan children. The Foundation has borne the expenses of many orphans who were sent for treatment in local or foreign hospitals, if the health condition required for that, in line with its responsibility.

From time to time, the Foundation conducts health awareness campaigns in cooperation with the Ministries of Social Affairs and Health to preserve the health of orphan children and considers them as a trust under its custody, so it does not feel burdened or bothered by them but rather it is keen to follow them on their health, and provide the necessary medicine for the patients from them regardless of the financial costs, even if some cases require to travel abroad.



Visiting and Inspecting Social Care Houses

The members of the board of directors of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation are always keen to visit and inspect the conditions of orphans in social care houses and family nurseries at the Ministry of Social Affairs so as to closely examine such cases that are being looked after or that need care by the Foundation, or to be informed of one of the construction or social projects, as well as visiting some institutions and authorities that take care of orphans or the people with special needs.

The aim of these visits is to strengthen the bonds of cooperation between the Foundation and the orphans and those who are in charge of their affairs. The visits in turn contribute to informing orphans that there are those who ask about them and their conditions and care about their affairs.

These visits also aim to closely examine the actual situation, whether of the social or construction projects, so that the necessary amendments can be conducted on them in the future and to avoid the negatives, if any. So, the Foundation is constantly keen to follow up these projects periodically during the implementation stages so as to produce any of these projects in its best form.





Orphan Marriage and Formation of New Families

In order to integrate orphans into society and considering them as a building block of its components, Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has always been keen to support the social life of orphans so as to help them form new families that contribute to the advancement of the society, and also to compensate them for being deprived of their original families that they lost due to orphanhood. The Foundation contributes to bearing the costs of marriage for those who are wishing to start a new family life by providing direct financial support to help them meet some of the needs and expenses of marriage through direct sums of money. Also, the Foundation tries to bear the expense of renting a house for the spouses in the event that there are no good financial capabilities available for such couples.

The goal of the financial support for orphans- marriage is one of the most noble paths that the Foundation seeks to achieve, in order to preserve the social existence of orphans and to preserve them and cover them with the law of God, in order to form new families that can compensate them for their deprivation of the orphanhood they lived before.



Public and Religious Competitions

There is no doubt that orphans and people with special needs represent an important segment among the segments of the society that should not be neglected, so that the charitable organizations, societies and public benefit institutions can contribute to working to integrate them into the society. Public competitions, religious competitions and prizes for memorizing the Noble Qur'an are one of the ways to participate with other groups of society who have families and who can take care of them and look after their interests.

Hence, the Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has been focusing on developing the competitive sense of orphans and encouraging them to ride the wave of honest & fair competition in various fields of public life that suit their ages. And that can be achieved by supporting them and involving them in these competitions. These competitions aim to raise the awareness among orphans and encourage them to read books and learn about them, in addition to getting acquainted with public affairs, and it is a very important way to integrate orphans into society, especially since these competitions encourage honorable and praiseworthy competition that strengthens in the psyche of the orphan child the incentive to continue in life, to have the spirit of struggle and perseverance.





Sports Activities

Sport is a rock on which desires are destroyed. It strengthens the will of those who practice it, and it encourages him to have the spirit of perseverance and patience in order to achieve tangible sports progress.

Khairal-Kuwait Foundation reassures that sport is an important and fundamental aspect of orphans> lives that cannot be dispensed with. Rather, it must be supported and encouraged by holding sports competitions between orphans so as to encourage them to love sports by holding marathons, sports matches and offering prizes to those who achieve advanced positions in these competitions, in order to preserve the body and health of orphans.

Also, the Foundation has always been sure to make them attend the official football and sports championships in Kuwait so that they could share a feeling with the masses in the stands that they are a part of the society and not strangers to it.





Celebration of the Arab Orphan Day

The Arab Orphan Day is one of the most important Arab events that take place in all countries of the Arab world, including Kuwait. The Foundation has confirmed its support for these events and their establishment or participation in them locally in cooperation with the Ministry of Social Affairs, believing that the Arab orphan child must be served in an integrated manner, and through such events the experiences and aspects of integration with Arab countries and between each other are highlighted during the month of April of each year.

Perhaps the link that binds the Arab orphan in all of our Arab countries is that our honorable Messenger, may God's prayers and peace be upon him, recommended us to the orphan when he said: (I and the sponsor of the orphan will be in Paradise like this, and he pointed with the forefinger and the middle and separated between them). This is what gave the policy of dealing with an Arab orphan a special flavor that is characterized by tenderness and compassion, as the Foundation was keen to communicate with the relevant Arab actors in this aspect to honor the orphan.



Sponsoring Orphans Ceremonies and Festivals

Bringing pleasure and joy into the psyches and hearts of orphans is the greatest charity and the best favor, through which its owner will get the reward. From this standpoint, Khairal-Kuwait Foundation organizes many parties and entertainment festivals that will raise the spirits of orphans, especially children among them, in order to erase the orphanhood>s streak from their foreheads.

The Foundation was quite keen that these parties & ceremonies are sponsored by senior state officials so that this disadvantaged group feels that they are not forgotten and that they are always in in the minds of the state and decision makers. The Foundation was also keen to sponsor and organize ceremonies for honoring the outstanding students in their studies from the orphan children, as well as organizing entertainment parties for the disabled and their families to honor them for their donation. The sponsorship of the parties includes private or public events, whether religious or national, such as Gargian, Children's Day, national holidays, Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha, in order to bring joy and happiness to them.





Media Campaign to Embrace Orphans by Families

Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has implemented a media and awareness campaign in Kuwaiti society under the title: «Color Your Life» for accepting orphans in the homes of Kuwaiti families and their integration with these families and their children, because families usually hesitate to embrace orphans in their homes expecting the difficulty of accepting these orphans by their families, their children and the society around them. The Foundation succeeded in this incubation campaign, in which many volunteers, media professionals and artists participated. This campaign had a positive impact on Kuwaiti society, and gave a positive idea about incubating orphans in accordance with the provisions of Islamic law.

So, many families began to embrace orphans with their children so as to live with them in their homes, in stable and reassuring families, and they are brought up in a sound psychological, educational and health upbringing.



Membership of the Union of Charitable Societies



Khairal-Kuwait Foundation sought, many years ago, to present a proposal to create a special union for Kuwaiti charitable societies, and the Foundation was keen to call for the establishment of a union in order to coordinate efforts among themselves and exchange experiences and experiments. Upon establishing the Kuwaiti Charitable Societies Union, Khairal-Kuwait Foundation was keen to join this union, which helps to unify the efforts of charitable societies in the State of Kuwait. The Chairman of the Board of Directors of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation, Mr. Nasser Muhammad Al-Ayyar, has been elected to be a member of the Board of Directors of the Union of Charitable Societies in the 2020 session. The union has made great efforts during the Corona crisis in unifying and coordinating efforts between charitable societies, the Ministry of Social Affairs and civil & voluntary institutions. The union has also implemented many coordination projects to help the country face the Corona Virus.



Participate in National Holidays

The development of the national feeling among the Kuwaiti people is one of the most important factors that Khairal-Kuwait Foundation seeks to develop, so that the orphan who holds the nationality of Kuwait grows up to love this country, be affiliated to it and be loyal to it, because Kuwait is like the mother and father to all of them, especially since it took it upon itself to raise them and bring them up in good morals and good ideals.

Perhapsone of the best occasions in which the national feeling is embodied in the national holiday season is Independence Day on February 25 and Liberation Day on February 26. Khairal- Kuwait Foundation has been quite keen to revive this anniversary annually as well as its participation of orphans in celebrating it by holding festivals and celebrations. The parties on national holidays are not limited to celebrating only the parties held in social care houses, but also include visits to museums, theaters and major celebrations to strengthen orphans' sense of belonging to this dear homeland.



Lectures and Seminars

The educational and religious lectures and seminars for orphans and other groups that benefit from the services of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation are one of the goals of the organization to create a generation that is aware, educated, adheres to its religion and maintains its pillars.

The Foundation has sponsored many seminars and lectures for orphans according to each age group to educate them and work on their integration into the society through it.

Also, the Foundation focuses on holding religious lectures on various occasions, for example receiving the month of Ramadan to clarify and simplify the obligation according to the age of each group among them. The aim of these lectures and seminars is to increase the dose of general knowledge and education in various life and religious matters, and to facilitate the delivery of information to the parties benefiting from these lectures and seminars, which are a quick means of education and knowledge acquisition in a quick and short manner.



Training Courses and Workshops

One of the important and vital roles of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation in the field of serving orphans and people with disabilities is to encourage volunteer work and enhance its role in building the Kuwaiti society, by raising awareness of the rights, needs and concerns of these groups and how to help them, whether financially, morally or socially, in any way appropriate for the party wishing to help them as well as how to deal with them so as to try to improve their conditions and situations.

Among the objectives of establishing the foundation is to train Kuwaiti cadres for a number of social and psychological specialists so as to deal with orphans. Also, one of the goals of the organization is to work on training orphans and qualifying them to create job opportunities for this category in cooperation with official and private authorities. There is no doubt that the whole world today depends on workshops and training courses to deliver information or acquire skills, quickly, concise and accurate at the same time.





Exhibitions

Organizing exhibitions and charitable markets is one of the means of direct community communication between the orphan and the community. Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has been keen on holding periodic and annual charitable exhibitions and markets whose proceeds have been allocated to the benefit of orphans, and among these exhibitions are «White Expo», «Hala Expo» and «Ahlan Ramadan», which is one of the most favorable means of helping orphans in a way that guarantees them preserving their dignity as well as providing them with psychological and financial support, at the same time.

The Foundation also participates in many other exhibitions held in the State of Kuwait that are closely related to the field of volunteer and humanitarian work, and other exhibitions of a humanitarian character in order to support and help orphans and people with special needs. The exhibitions are considered as one of the best methods of marketing and indirect assistance that does not depend on the actual price of the commodity as much as it depends on its high returns and its impact on supporting orphans.





Annual Meeting of the Board of Directors

Undoubtedly, the work of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation continues to support and care for orphans and other target groups, such as people with special needs and others, by opening multiple areas for their service, and these ideas are collected through the different specializations of those in charge of the work in the organization, the founding members and the board of directors.

Therefore, the Foundation was keen on the annual meeting to discuss what has been accomplished in terms of work and other new work to serve orphans and other target groups.

Every time when an annual meeting is called, more innovative and invented ideas are presented in the interest of serving and caring for orphans, in the presence of all workers, volunteers and members of the working committees at the foundation.



Caring for People with Special Needs

Taking care of people with special needs is one of the goals that Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has added to its work strategy.

The Foundation has continuously sought in the process of integrating people with special needs into the civil society so that they can exercise their rights in education, work, production and creativity.

The foundation carried out several activities to take care of people with special needs by supporting them financially and logistically, and ensuring their participation in various events. The Foundation also organized more than one ceremony to celebrate the people with special needs a well as the heroes and the distinguished ones in the various sports and scientific fields. The Foundation also contributed to the completion of the education of some of the outstanding ones at the expense of the organization. The foundation has also provided a number of prosthetic devices for the people with special needs, such as wheelchairs and artificial limbs.





Elderly Care Efforts and Services

The Foundation was keen to diversify its services to include the elderly and the guests s of the Elderly Care Department in order to meet their social, health and financial needs to compensate them for what they lost in terms of family and home care.

Since its establishment, the Foundation has made various and regular visits to nursing homes in coordination with the Ministry of Social Affairs, through which it provided gifts, material support and in-kind donations with some of the devices they need, and has also visited them during different holidays and seasons, and provided buffets for breakfast and lunch and held entertainment parties for them in order to make them happy.

The Foundation concluded cooperation protocol with the Scout Society, and held some joint activities and provided gifts to them. As a result of the concerted efforts of the Foundation in serving the elderly in accordance with international standards, it was granted the membership of the International Federation of Aging on October 2019,27.



Corona Crisis 2020

The Khairal-Kuwait Foundation, in cooperation with Kuwaiti charitable societies, contributed to combating the Corona Virus, through the participation by the Foundation in the National Campaign of Charitable Societies to mobilize efforts to combat the Corona crisis under the title «Help Kuwait». The Foundation has carried out several awareness and educational actions in which it called on the Kuwaiti community to adhere to the decisions of the official state institutions to preserve the safety of society, confront the virus, stop its spread, combat and eradicate it.





EXTERNAL PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES





External Projects and Activities

Just as Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has local projects and activities, in return it has a media resonance outside the State of Kuwait and relations and cooperation protocols with regional and international organizations as well as similar organizations working in the same field of the work of the Foundation, so that services are provided at the highest level as a result of exchanging experiences with these bodies.

The communication with regional and international institutions by The Foundation contributed to the creation of new project ideas and activities in the Foundation to be applied locally, and external parties also benefited from the local projects that the Foundation implemented in the State of Kuwait.

With regard to the external projects carried out by the Foundation, it varied between cooperation protocols, visits, membership in these organizations and partnerships with them, as well as periodic visits and participation in international events as well as candidacy for international and international competitions and prizes in order to serve orphans and people with special needs. In cooperation and coordination with Kuwaiti charities, the Foundation has also contributed to providing support and relief to the afflicted. Since its establishment in 2007, the Foundation has been able to take vigorous steps towards regional and international cooperation, and has signed cooperation and partnership agreements in addition to implementing many projects and activities by virtue of its openness to the outside world, and not just providing its services locally, and we would like to mention from these activities and projects, the following:

Protocols of Cooperation with Regional and International Bodies



The conclusion of cooperation protocols with regional and international organizations and United Nations organizations is one of the goals that the Foundation seeks to achieve, with its standards that can be generalized to the work of the public benefit societies and the civil society institutions.

The Foundation has concluded many protocols with regional and international bodies and organizations related to the field of human rights and the right of the orphan child to life and well-being, in order to provide better service in this field.

These protocols would improve the institutional work of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation and provide an integrated picture of it, as well as contributing to benefiting from the experiences of others in the field of combating orphanhood and its treatment according to the latest methods used in all

Reviving activities in the field of honoring and caring for orphans is one of the concerns of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation, and there are regional and international events to celebrate the orphan, including the Arab Orphan Day in April of every year, where in these activities it focuses on orphans and tries to make them happy by giving gifts and accompanying them on various trips, and it is from the distinct things that an orphan rejoices in while taking care of him during the rest of the year by providing him with care at all times.

The Foundation was also keen to participate in international forums and conferences, such as the Geneva International Forum that was organized at the United Nations in Switzerland from 10 to 14 December 2018, and to visit the United Nations headquarters in New York and Geneva.

Relief Aid



The Khairal-Kuwait Foundation did not only provide support and care for orphans and some other target groups, but the Foundation was also keen to provide assistance and donation to relief campaigns for brotherly and friendly countries, by supporting local charities that run relief convoys for the people of these countries to face natural disasters, wars and calamities. This included the Foundation's aid provided to the Syrian people after the escalation of the ongoing war there and the flight of refugees to neighboring countries, as a contribution from the Foundation in support of charitable and relief work. Providing relief materials indirectly through donations to major Kuwaiti charities that are able to deliver relief to every needy person in all parts of the world, as the Foundation believes in its role in combating hunger, poverty and destitution facing humanity.

Visiting Regional and International Organizations



A closer look is the proof of experience. Therefore, those in charge of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation were keen to exchange visits with regional public benefit societies, international organizations and bodies, with the aim of evaluating the local experience and assessing the various achievements it has achieved, in addition to looking forward to transferring external experiences in line with the nature of local civil society institutions.

Since the establishment of the Foundation and the beginning of its work, it made several visits, including visiting the headquarters of the League of Arab States in several activities, and visiting the headquarters of the SOS organization to children's villages in Vienna, Austria, from 16 to 17 December 2018.

International Competitions and Prizes



After a busy course of local and regional achievements of the Khairal-Kuwait Foundation, it was necessary to enter the field of competition for various awards in the field of volunteer and humanitarian work, in appreciation of its tireless efforts and great work in the field of serving orphans and people with disabilities.

The Foundation has been honored in several local, regional and international competitions and events, including the honor that was given to the Foundation by the Donor NGO Conference in the Arab Countries, which was held in Bahrain on December ,20 2015, and a medal of appreciation from the National Assembly of the Algerian Republic, which was awarded to the Sheikha Faryal Duaij Al-Sabah. The Foundation is also keen to participate in competitions of an international nature, including participation in the Sheikh Fahd Al-Ahmad International Prize for Charitable Work organized by the General Secretariat of Endowments on January 18, 2010.



LOCAL COOPERATION AND PARTNEHIP AGREEMENT



Local Cooperation and Partnership Agreements

Since the issuance of the decision of its declaration in December 2007 ,31, Khairal-Kuwaiti Foundation has been keen to communicate with the relevant bodies and institutions closely related to its work in the field of public benefit to serve orphans and improve their conditions in their social care homes, to consolidate the spirit of citizenship in them and to ensure job opportunities for them in cooperation with the official authorities and eligibility, in addition to training Kuwaiti cadres of social and psychological specialists to deal with this category.

In order to achieve these noble goals, it was necessary for The Foundation to cooperate with local bodies, organizations and institutions with its cadres and practical experiences in the field of serving orphans and caring for them, in order to benefit from them in accordance with the nature of orphans in Kuwait, and in a manner that ensures that the latest methods are followed in dealing with them.

The Foundation has concluded several cooperation agreements and partnerships with many local bodies and organizations. It is also considered as one of the first charitable institutions that concluded cooperation agreements with official state institutions.

Ministry of Education



The Ministry of Education is the first teacher for students in the State of Kuwait, as it is the official body entrusted with raising and teaching young children.

Kuwait had been familiar with the formal education with the establishment of Al-Mubarakiya School in 1911, then it gradually expanded until the establishment of the Council and Department of Education in 1936, which later became the Ministry of Education.

Orphans are a category of students with special living and educational conditions. From this standpoint, the issue of integrating them into the normal educational process like their peers from students who have families and live in their homes stable between their parents. Therefore, Khairal-Kuwait Foundation signed a memorandum of cooperation with the Ministry of Education on November 2010, 4 with the aim of serving students from the category of orphans.

Ministry of Social Affairs





Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has signed a cooperation agreement with the Ministry of Social Affairs in order to serve its orphans to provide educational, social and educational programs, workshops and seminars in the field of rehabilitation and compensation for them being deprived of their family entity, and to provide entertainment services to compensate them for the feeling of orphan and deprivation, in cooperation and coordination with the Department of Charitable Societies and the Department of the Nursery Family, where the administration supervises orphans, children of unknown parentage, and children of fractured families in the State of Kuwait, and works to take care of them by providing a compensatory model that compensates them for their real families by providing them with social and psychological care, raising them a sound education on morals and correct behaviors, and keenness on their education. Upon completing their education, the Ministry of Social Affairs prepares them to form new families.

Kuwait Scout Society





In endeavors to integrate the orphan's category in the community, it was a commitment to make them participate in all student & volunteer activities just like their peers. Among the activities of the Scout Society, the Foundation has signed a joint cooperation agreement with Kuwait Scout Society 1n 18th April 2011 for spreading and enhancing the values & principles of the scout movement in line with the national, GCC, Arab, Islamic and international established principles in order to prepare the young people and youth to contribute to the service and development of the community, by providing integrated experiences to the young people and youth in order to make them ready for contributing to realizing the development goals and the needs of the community. The Foundation has provided material and moral support to the Scout Society. The Scout Society has granted the Foundation scout & GCC medals in appreciation to its efforts and support to the scout movement.
Kuwait Scout Girls Society





The Kuwait Scout Girls Society is supervising all GCC, Arab and international activities & programs it receives from the external entities and in turn it provides to Student Activities Sector in the Ministry of Education (represented by the General Guidance & Technical Guidance for Scout Girls) so as to circulate to educational areas, private education and private education schools.

In order to integrate the category of orphan girls in the community, it was necessary to make them participate in all student & volunteer activities of their peers, so that they feel that there is no difference between them. From this springboard, the Foundation has signed a joint cooperation agreement with the Kuwait Scout Girls Society in 24th April 2013 for this purpose.





EXTERNAL COOPERATION AND PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENTS





Foreign Cooperation and Partnership Agreements

Just as Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has local partnership cooperation agreements, the Foundation was keen to conclude partnership and foreign cooperation agreements with regional and international organizations and associate Foundations in other countries. The aim of these agreements is for the Foundation to cooperate with regional and international bodies and institutions closely related to its work in the field of public benefit to serve orphans and improve their conditions in their social care homes, in order to instill education and teach them the teachings of their religion, morals and public behaviors.

The Foundation was able to conclude many foreign agreements and partnerships in a short period of time, and the Foundation was keen to exchange experiences between it and these foundations to advance the process of enhancing the presence of orphans in society and the advancement of them and their conditions in all fields.

In its choices to s0ign external cooperation agreements, the Foundation has made sure that these organizations are officially accredited in their country and that they bear the international institutional and organizational character so that cooperation is fruitful and beneficial to both parties.

The Foundation is not satisfied with concluding agreements and partnerships with associate organizations. Rather, the Foundation joined international organizations or affiliated with the United Nations, and all of this was mainly aimed at serving orphans. Among the bodies with which to arrange a cooperation agreement in the coming days is the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, Kuwait Branch.

Egyptian Orman House

Whereas the work of the Khairal-Kuwait Foundation requires it to build bridges of cooperation between civil efforts and governmental efforts, both local and foreign, in the areas of community service, so the Foundation signed a cooperation protocol with the Egyptian Orman Society in Masila Palace on February 2010,7 with the aim of benefiting from the Foundation>s projects in caring for orphans and families. Special needs to achieve societal development, and the exchange of common experiences between them to achieve the greatest benefit in the field of work of Khairal-Kuwait Foundation to serve orphans and people with special needs.

The Egyptian Orman House Society is an Egyptian nongovernmental organization that was established in 1993 and aims to serve all needy groups of Egyptian society, and has great experience in the field of caring and serving normal orphans and handicapped orphans.

United Nations Human Settlements Program (HABITAT)





The Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has signed a letter of intent with the United Nations Human Settlements Program (HABITAT) through their office in the State of Kuwait on March 2012 ,26, to implement community service programs and orphans in accordance with the lofty goals of the United Nations Program. The United Nations Human Settlements Program (HABITAT) encourages the United Nations to build towns and cities that are sustainable, socially and environmentally, and the program is the focal point for all issues of urbanization and human settlements in the United Nations. This program envisages cities and other human settlements to be well-planned, well-managed, and efficient, with adequate housing and infrastructure, and universal access to jobs and basic services such as water, energy and sanitation.





Khairal-Kuwait Foundation has signed a cooperation protocol with Misr El Mahrousa «Baladi» Society on December 2016,17, with the aim of exchanging experiences and joint projects to serve orphans in Kuwait, and reviewing the society>s latest developments in the field of service and care for orphans to implement the same ideas in Kuwaiti society.

Misr Al-Mahrousa «Baladi» Society is a non-profit organization that takes care of orphans, mothers and widows, and works charitable projects that participate in reform efforts with developmental, educational and educational programs for children, youth and women to enable them to invest their capabilities and resources available to them to achieve individual happiness and well-being. The branches of the Misr Al-Mahrousa Society are spread in several governorates in Egypt, and the Society works in several voluntary charitable projects to serve orphans and their families.

Membership of the International Federation of Aging





The Khairal-Kuwait Foundation was keen to obtain membership in various international organizations, in order to ensure that its work is carried out in accordance with international standards approved by major international organizations and United Nations organizations, and it has a legal umbrella to ensure that it provides its services locally at the highest level, and that also enables it to provide its services outside the State of Kuwait.

The Foundation has also been keen to expand the base of its services provided so that the matter is not limited to the category of orphans only, but also to serve those with special needs and the elderly. Therefore, Khairal-Kuwait Foundation, represented by the Chairman of the Board of Directors Mr. Nasser Muhammad Al-Ayyar, became a member of the Board of Directors of the International Federation of Aging in Toronto, Canada, and this was officially announced in London on October 2019,27.

Since the first day of the declaration of Khairal-Kuwait Charity Foundation on December 31, 2007 and the beginning of its actual work, the Foundation has been able to provide many services to the category of orphans and then those with special needs, and thus the Foundation has been able to achieve many achievements during more than 14 years since its establishment.
